1. Accommodation at respective hotel with buffet breakfast (as mentioned)
2. SIC Hong Kong city – Pier transfer (with one luggage transport) from below pick up points:
 - a) From HKG Airport (between 0700 hrs – 2200 hrs & every 60 min per shuttle) OR
 - b) From Disney Hotel (2 pick up time: morning & 1330 hrs) OR
 - c) From HKG City hotel (morning only)
 - d) Disney & City hotel transfers for only those passengers who book the HKG / Disney package)
3. SIC Macau Pier transfer

 - c) Passenger pick up from Hong Kong city hotel will join the tour directly, tour guide will drop off to Macau hotel after the tour
 - d) Optional cost for Macau Tower admission ticket = USD 30 per person (adult/child)
 - e) Upgrade to Indian lunch during Macau city tour = USD 20 per person per meal (adult/child)
5. 2 ways day ferry ticket (9 a.m. – 4 p.m.) between HKG city pier – Macau – HKG Airport OR HKG Airport – Macau – HKG city pier
 - a) Upgrade to Night ferry (4 pm - 8 am) USD 30 per ticket

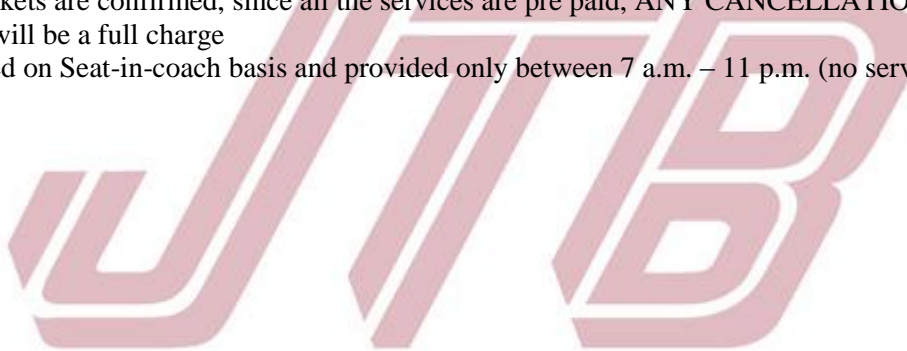

HIGHLIGHTS OF MACAU

A – Ma Temple

This temple is distinguished by beautiful tiled roofs and spectacular views from the upper gardens.

Penha Church

This chapel, situated on Penha Hill, offers breathtaking views of Macau

Ruins of St Paul

All that remains of the greatest of Macau's churches is its magnificent stone facade and grand staircase. The ruins are regarded as the symbol of Macau

Senado Square

The Senado square has a wave-patterned mosaic pavement of coloured stones, created by Portuguese experts. This pavement with its little streets branching out makes the heart of the city a pedestrian paradise.

Grand Prix Museum

A spectacular display of cars, bikes and other Grand Prix memorabilia in this Museum

Wine Museum

A museum dedicated to exquisite Portuguese wines. Visitors can enjoy a wine-tasting session after touring the museum

Greyhound Races

Bet on your favourite greyhound dogs and cheer them as they race towards victory! Greyhound races are a must-see in Macau! The Greyhound races are held on Monday, Thursday, Friday, Saturday and Sunday from 19:25 hrs to 23:00 hrs.

Casinos

There are plenty of casinos in Macau offering probably the widest range of games in the world, including baccarat, blackjack, roulette etc. The Sands Casino, a Las Vegas enterprise, is one of the new casinos in Macau. Visitors are advised to carry their passports while visiting the casinos. Casinos are open 24 hours a day. No tip required. It is recommended that visitors read signs at the entrances to chance only what they can afford.

Macau Tower:

Soaring 338 metres above the city, the Macau Tower is the 10th highest freestanding tower in the world and the 8th tallest in Asia. It stands taller than Auckland's Sky Tower, Paris' Eiffel and Sydney's AMP Tower. **Skywalk X**, is a very thrilling walk around the main outer rim of the tower, 233 meters above ground. Safety is guaranteed by a world-first overhead rail system. Make your way around the outside of the Tower, 216 meters above ground, on a see-through metal grate. No special technical skills or level of fitness required - just a cool head and nerves of steel.

Kum Iam Temple

Located on the Outer Harbour, this statue, dedicated to Goddess of Kun Iam (Goddess of Mercy) is 20 meters tall and made of special bronze. The dome shape base is like a lotus flower

Taipa & Coloane Islands

The islands of Taipa and Coloane are Macau's outlying islands. Taipa preserves its heritage in Chinese temples, restored colonial homes and traditional shop houses containing family-style restaurants. Coloane also has a picturesque village and plenty of good restaurants.
